and the Grand Jurors, aforesaid, in the name and behalf of the citizens of Georgia, further charge and accuse **ELISEO MOCTEZUMA, JR.** with the offense of **AGGRAVATED ASSAULT, O.C.G.A. 16-5-21**, for that the said accused person, in the County of Cobb and State of Georgia, **on or about the 26th day of March, 2020**, did make an assault upon Lesly Lopez, by discharging, without legal justification, a firearm from within a motor vehicle toward the direction of said person, contrary to the laws of said State, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.
